First Crop Illinois Peaches, Sweet Corn and Tomatoes

Green and yellow beans, sweet corn, new potatoes, cucumbers, cabbage, squash, leeks, peppers, early tomatoes, egg plant, cauliflower, broccoli, cauliflower, peaches and blackberries are increasing in production as Friday morning pickings provide amounts available.

Also growing is the number of local vendors. This Friday, July 2, 2010, seven vendors are registered with additional vendors expected.
